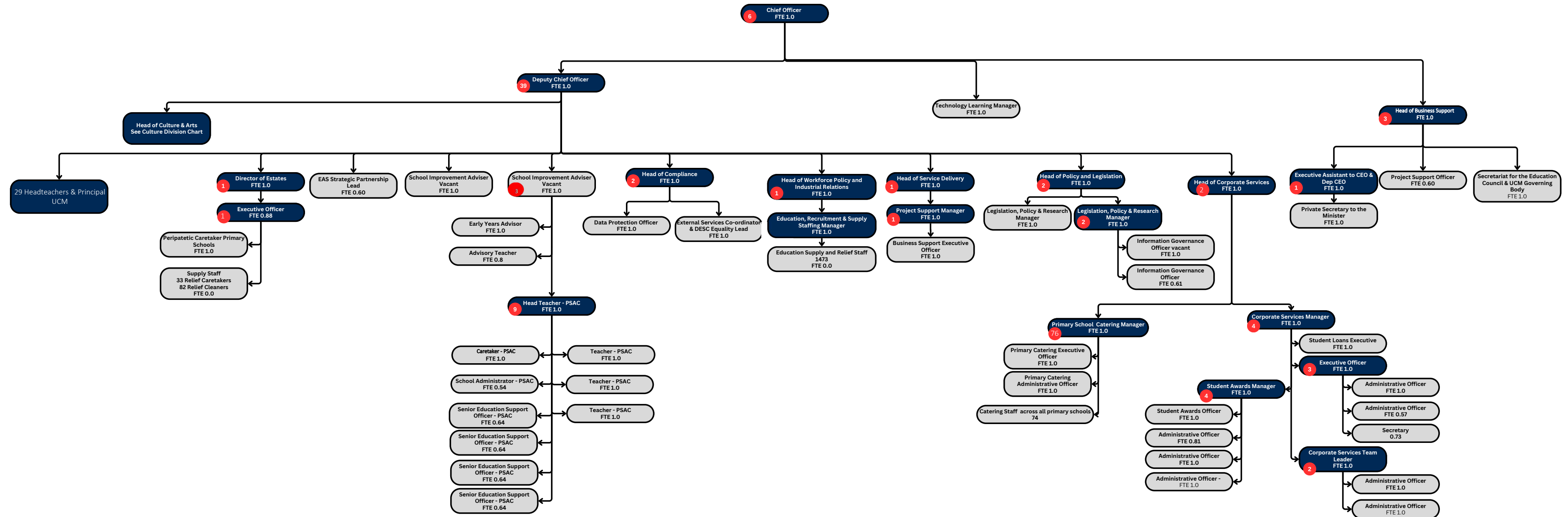
The Minister for Education, Sport and Culture (Mrs Caine):

Please find attached the organisation charts for the Department broken down by division.

Please note:

- Some line management is cross-divisional, and this is illustrated on the relevant organisation charts.
- Vacant posts have been included.
- In relation to casual, supply, bank and relief staff, the organisation charts indicate that responsibility for managing these staff (for PiP, timesheets and mandatory training) sits with a number of identified managers.
- The Sport, Recreation and Youth Division is split into three organisational charts for ease of viewing. These charts include: National Sports Centre, Sports Development and Youth.
- In the Policy, Strategy and Governance Division chart, headteachers, the Principal of UCM and the Head of Culture and Arts are shown; this is due to cross-divisional management.
- The Chief Officer role appears on each divisional organisation chart, however, is only included in the head count for the Policy, Strategy and Governance Division.
- The Chief Officer role has the following direct reports:
 - Deputy Chief Officer
 - Head of Business Support
 - Technology Learning Manager
 - Director of Learning for Work
 - Head of Sport, Recreation and Youth
 - Director of the Education, Advice and Support Division
- Following clarification, the Hon. Member for Glenfaba and Peel confirmed that it was not necessary for organisation charts for schools to be included.

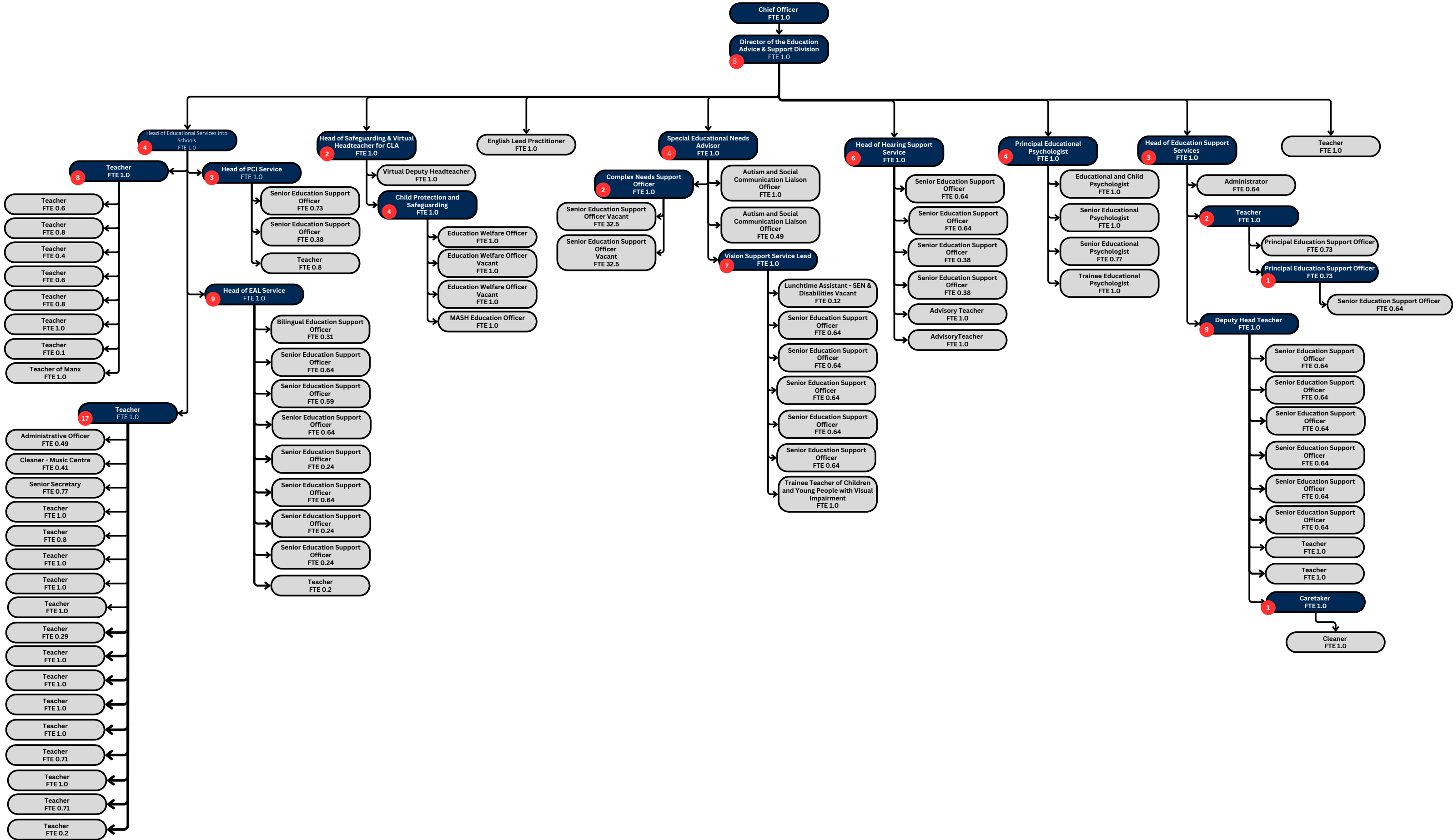
Department of Education Sports and Culture - Policy, Strategy and Governance March 2026



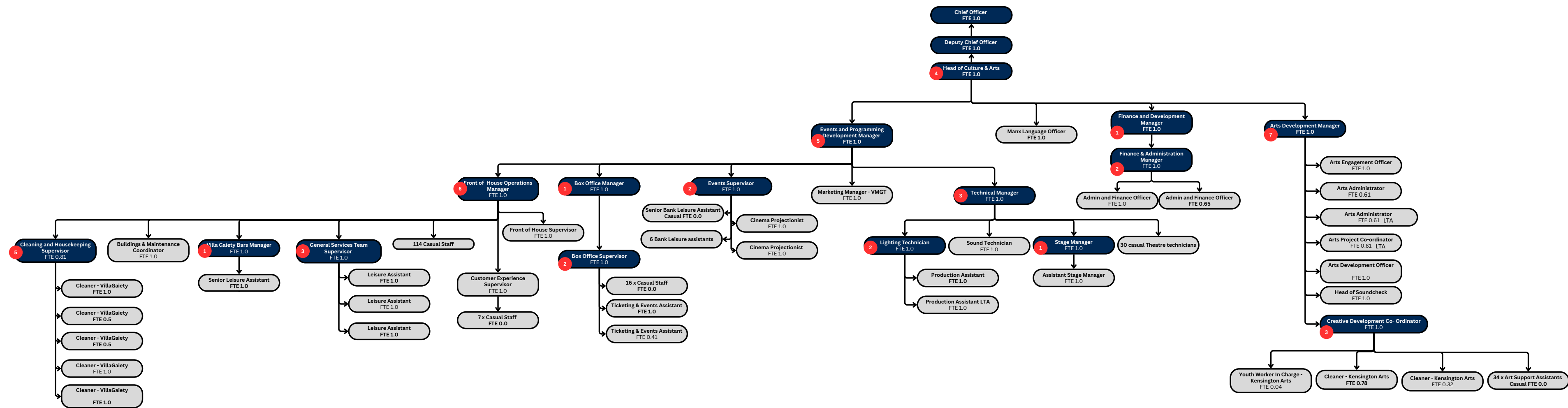
Notes:

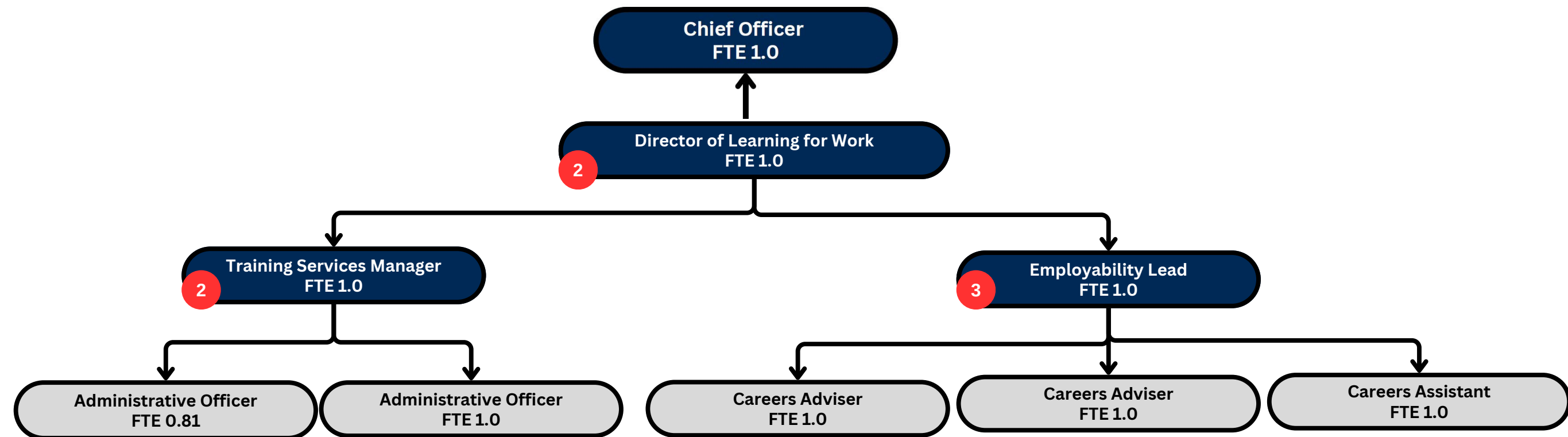
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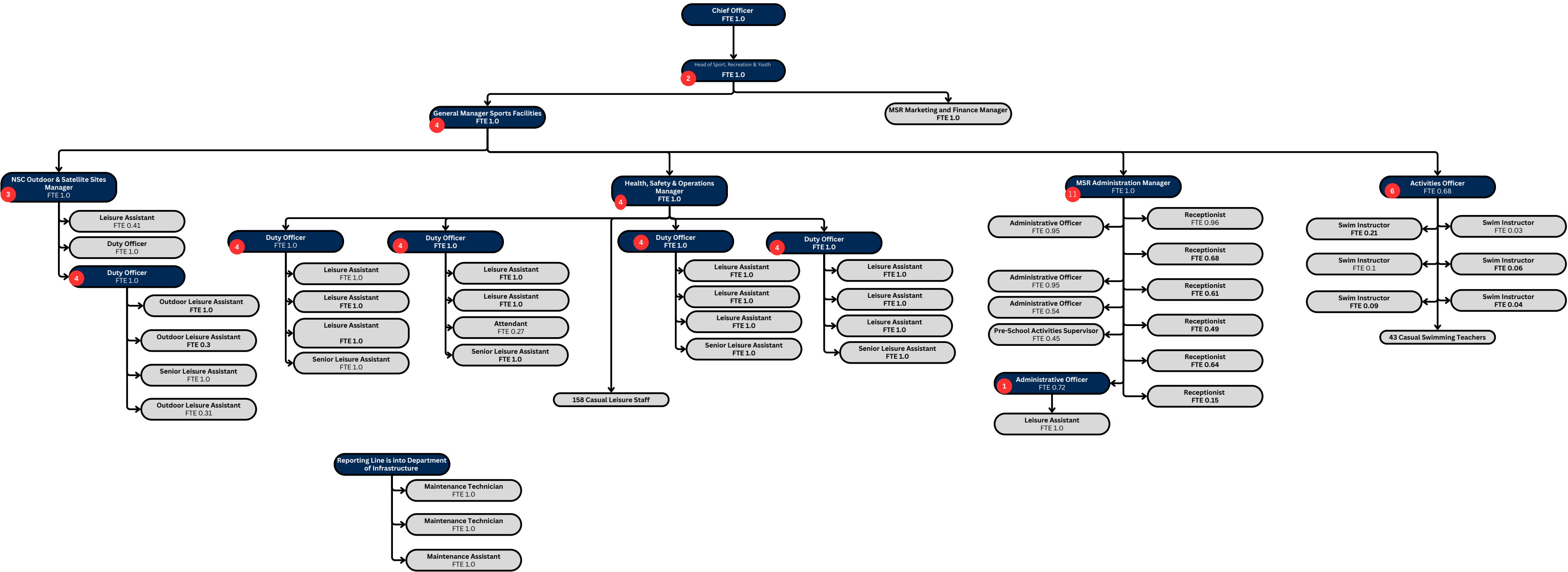
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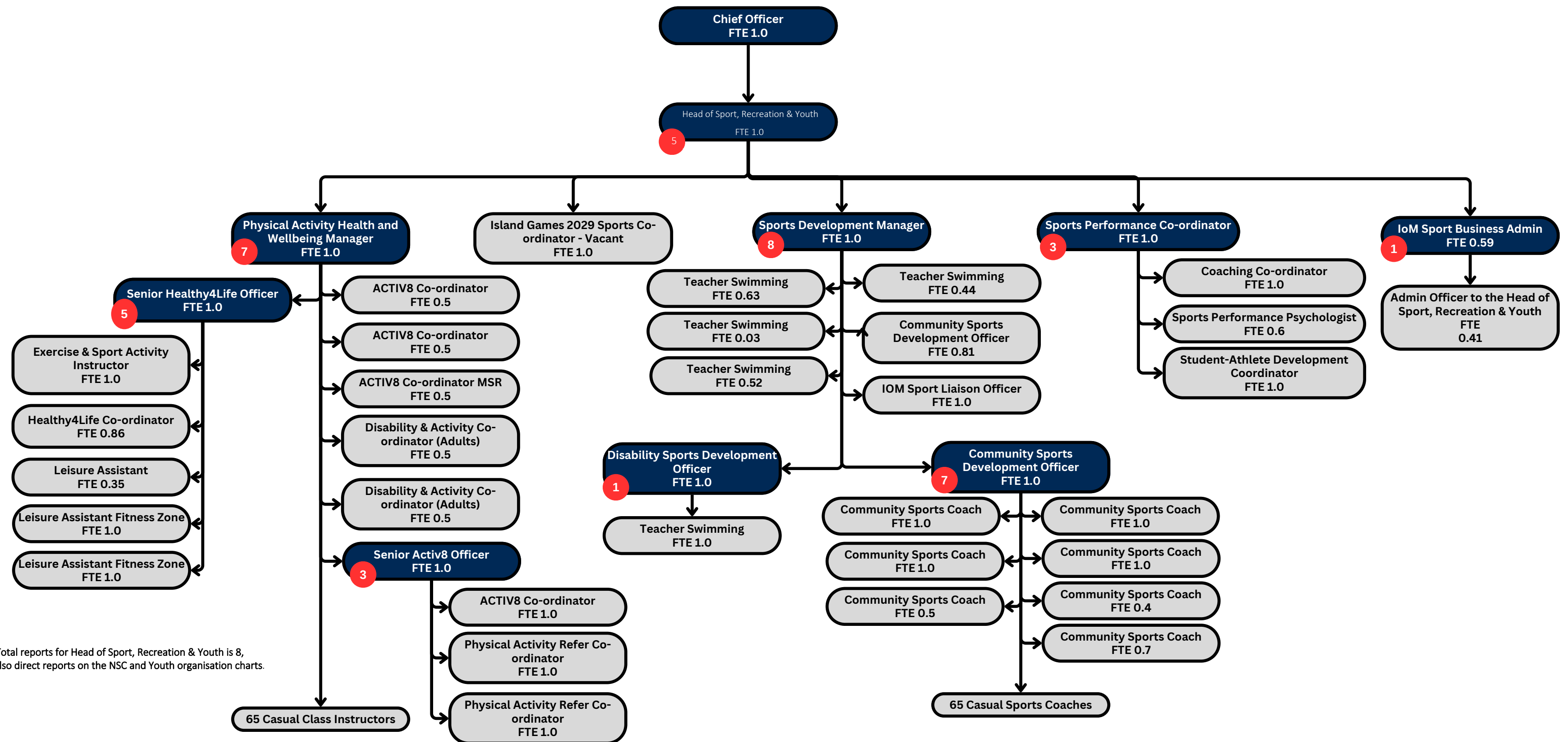
Department of Education Sports and Culture - Learning for Work March 2026
