The use of data extracted from PIP has not been used for the Constabulary's organisation chart as publication of such data could risk the disclosure of operationally sensitive information.

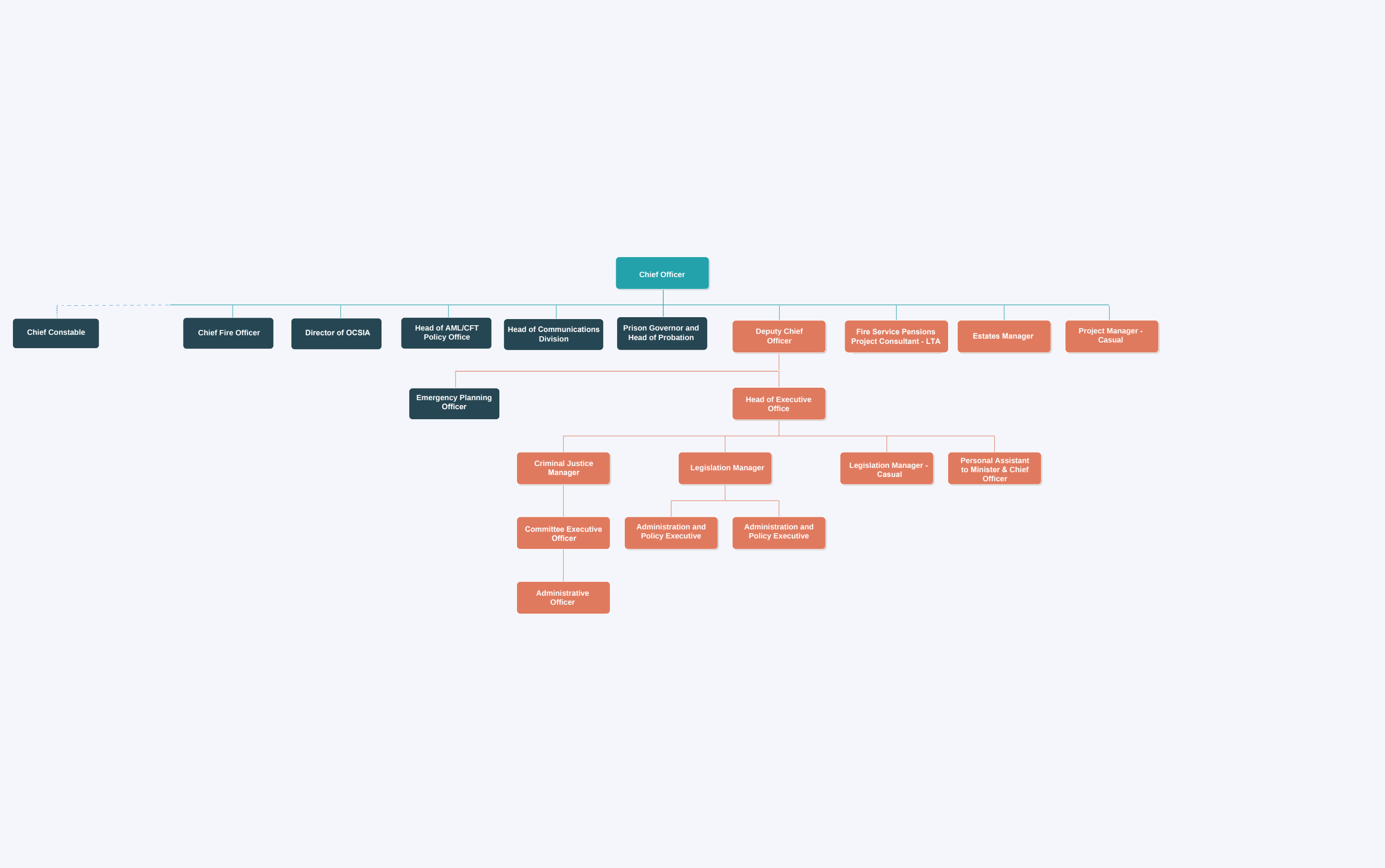

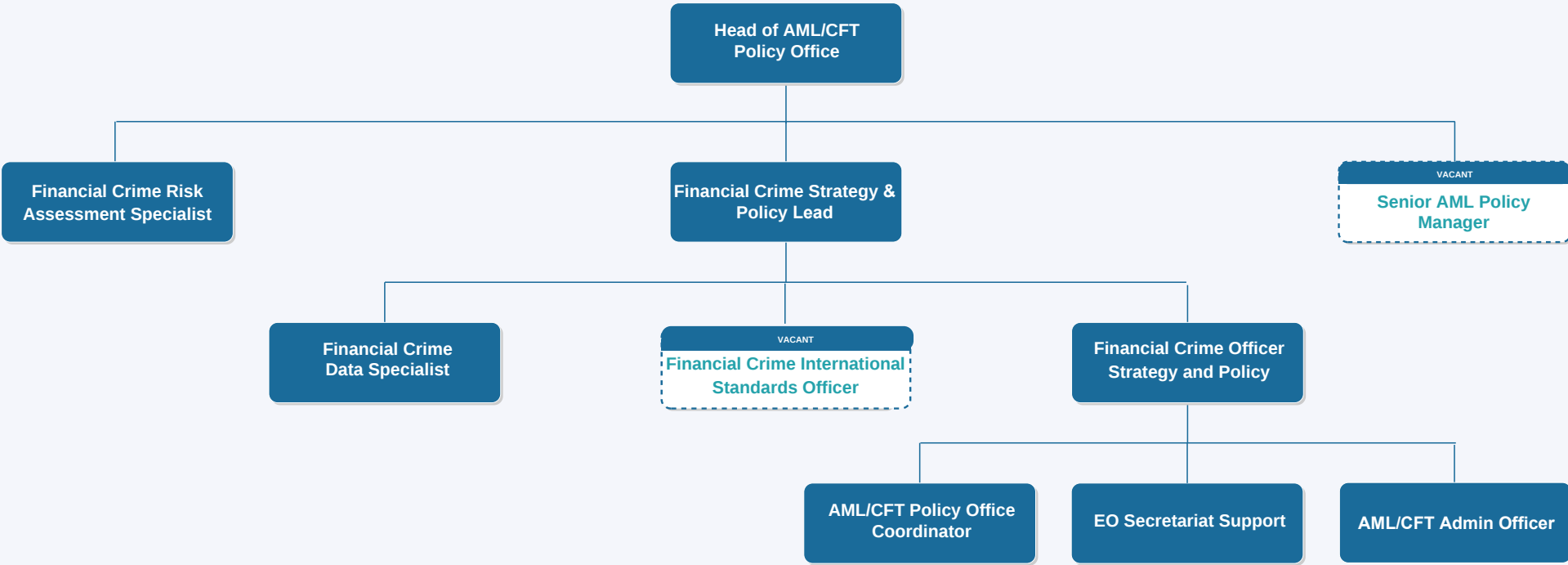

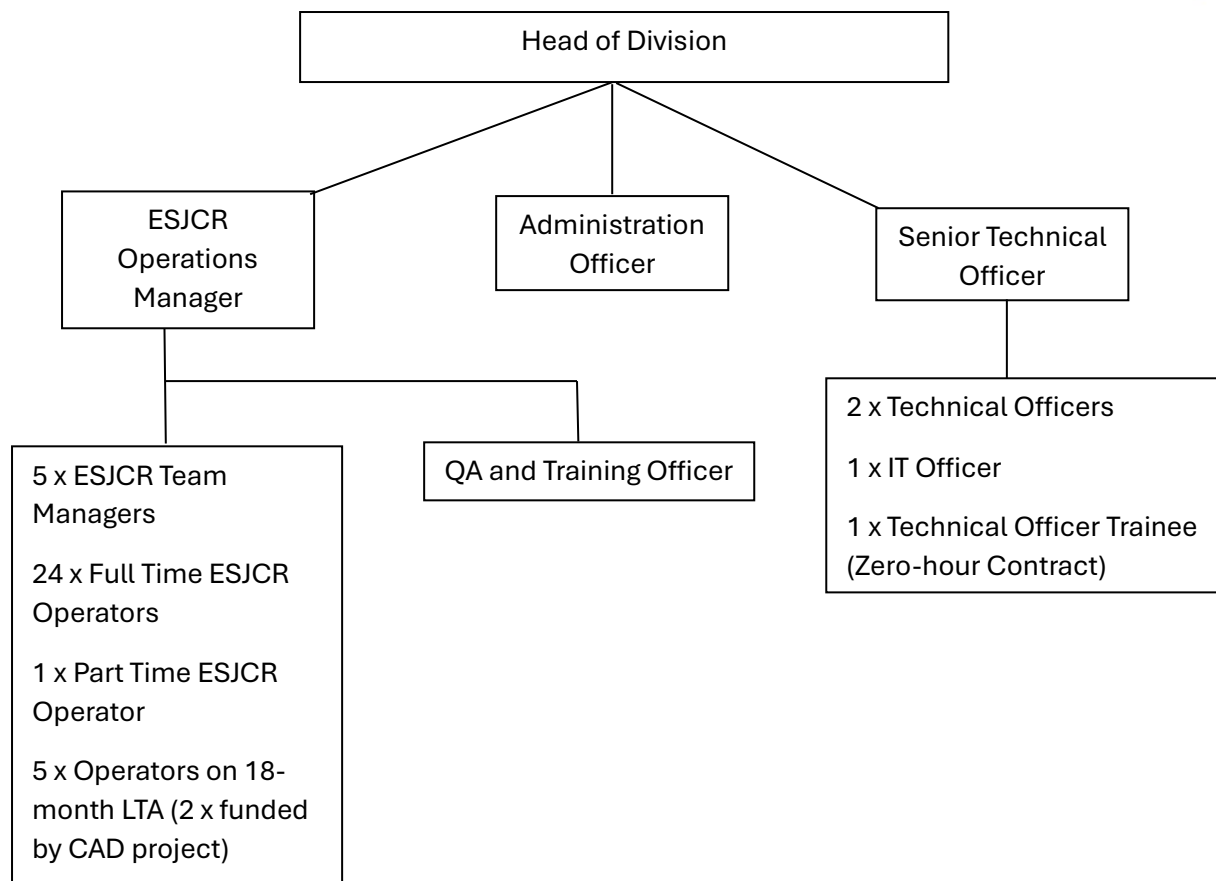
Executive Office - DHA



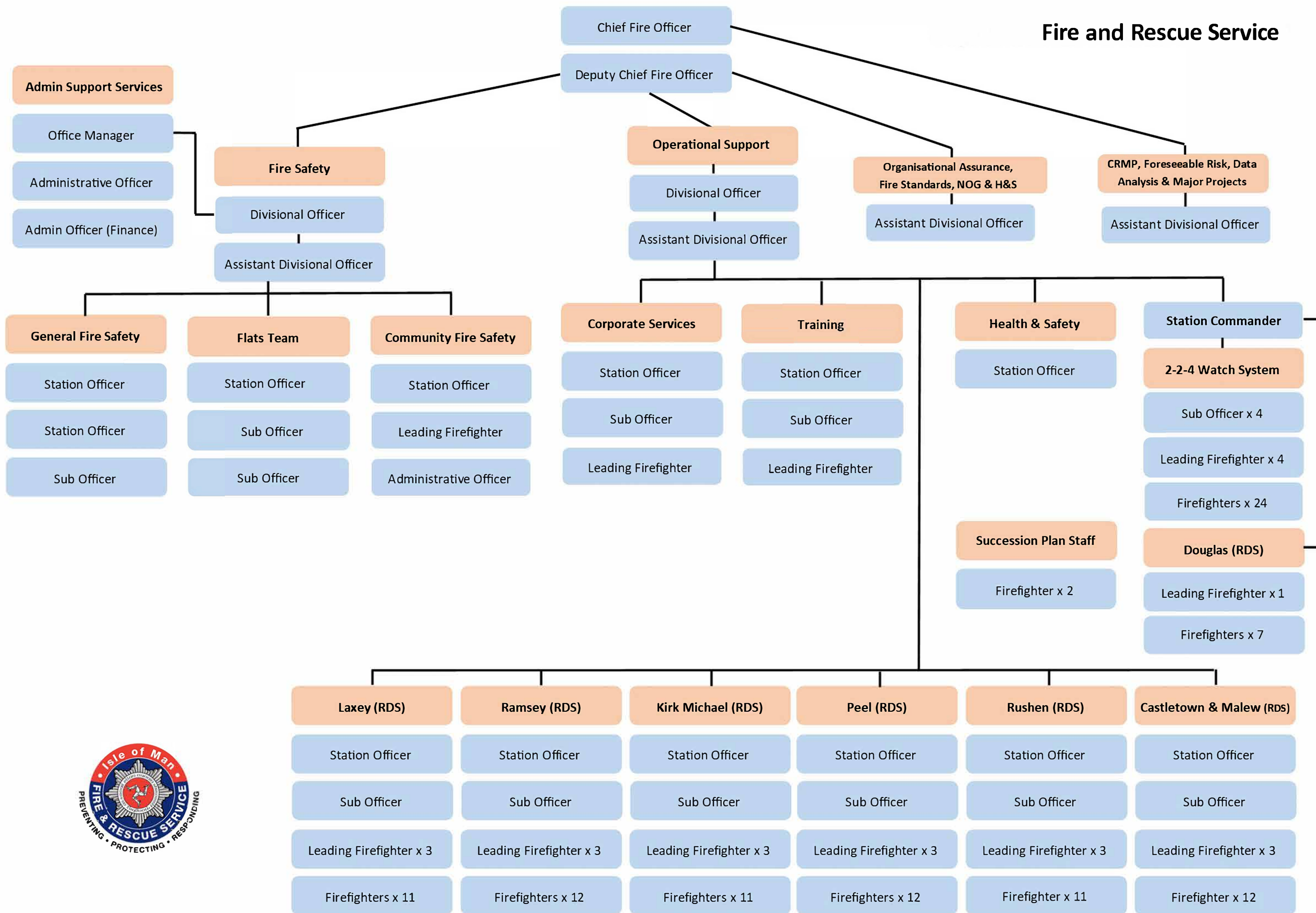
AML/CFT Policy Office



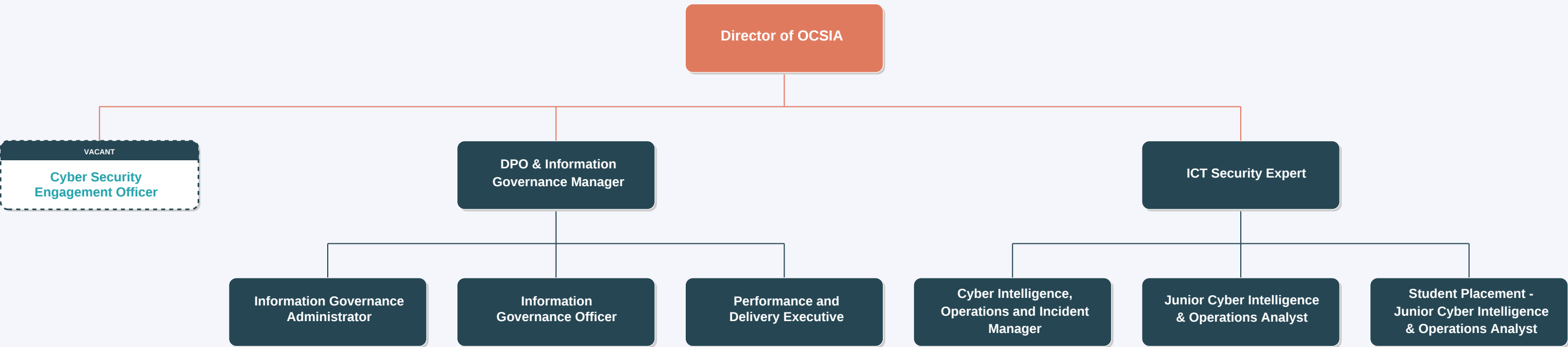
Communications Division Organogram



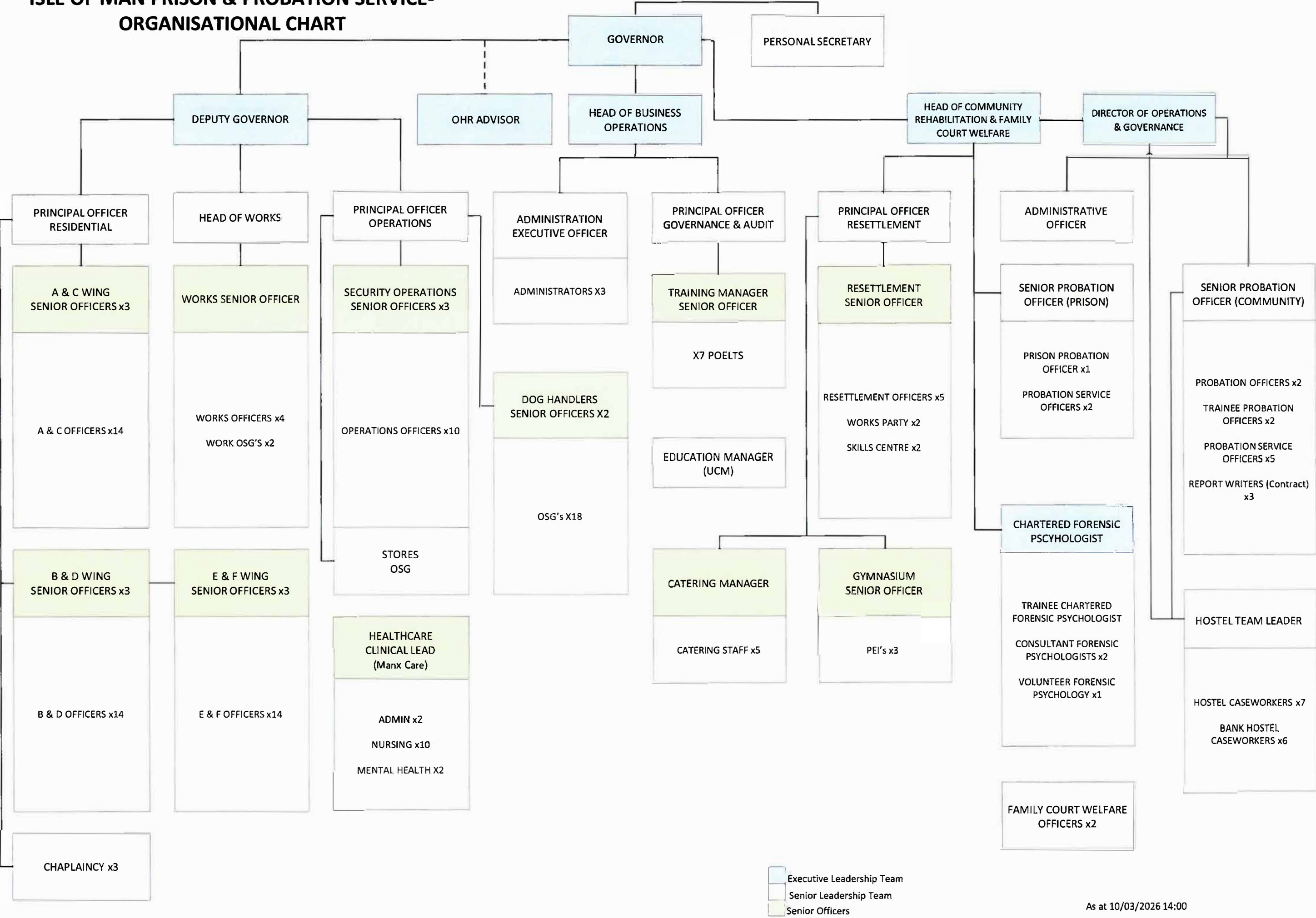
